

UL LAFAYETTE COLLEGE OF NURSING AND ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS
STUDENT HEALTH/HOSPITALIZATION INSURANCE CERTIFICATION

The students in the College of Nursing and Allied Health Professions may be exposed to multiple communicable diseases while caring for clients in clinical settings and may be at a higher risk than other university students for contracting a communicable disease. For this reason, all students enrolled in clinical nursing courses are required to maintain health/medical/accident insurance coverage while enrolled in clinical courses.

The UL Lafayette ACCIDENT ONLY Plan, included with registration fees for students taking the requisite number of hours is supplemental in nature, is not sufficient to cover expenses for an extended illness, and will not provide comprehensive health coverage for an extended period. The College of Nursing and Allied Health Professions HIGHLY RECOMMENDS that students carry additional health/medical insurance that meets the requirements of the Affordable Care Act.

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette College of Nursing and Allied Health Professions **REQUIRES** that students enrolled in clinical nursing courses have health/medical/accident insurance. To meet this minimal requirement, students have two options:

1. Retain the UL Lafayette student ACCIDENT ONLY policy, the cost of which is included in the registration fees for **undergraduate students taking 7 or more hours in the Fall/Spring semesters and 4 or more hours in a Summer semester, and graduate students taking 6 or more hours in the Fall/Spring semesters and 3 or more hours in the Summer semester**, are covered under the terms of this ACCIDENT ONLY policy. This policy will allow benefits for expenses NOT covered by other valid collectible coverage as this is a secondary policy.

and/or

2. Provide proof of health/medical insurance coverage. All U.S. citizens are mandated by the federal government to carry health/medical/accident insurance that meets the guidelines of the Affordable Care Act. Please refer to the university's website, Office of Student Health Services, Student Insurance for additional information regarding insurance coverage options. It is highly recommended that students have this coverage.

Consult your local telephone directory for names of insurance companies that provide hospitalization insurance in your area. **If you require additional assistance in your effort to retain adequate insurance coverage, contact the College of Nursing and Allied Health Professions Student Services Office at 482-5604 Opt. 6.**
